



## **Mutual administrative and legal assistance in customs matters**

The following agreements between Switzerland and the UK will continue to apply on a bilateral level:

- The 2004 agreement between Switzerland and the EU on combating fraud;<sup>2</sup>
- The additional protocol between Switzerland and the EU on mutual assistance in customs matters;<sup>3</sup>
- Legal assistance in customs matters: the European Convention on Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters<sup>4</sup> and the second additional protocol on the European Convention on Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters.<sup>5</sup>

This means that there are no changes to mutual administrative and legal assistance either for government administration, private individuals or for businesses.
